

*23 Moreover, in those days I saw men of Judah who had married women from Ashdod, Ammon and Moab. 24 Half of their children spoke the language of Ashdod or the language of one of the other peoples, and did not know how to speak the language of Judah. 25 I rebuked them and called curses down on them. I beat some of the men and pulled out their hair. 2022 Met in person to 2023

- The numbers of children: <u>from 20 to 30 people</u> met in person by the grace of God.
- Kids moved up to youth. Children numbers decreased to 20 -25 kids in 2023

I. Why? Factors?

- The number of children decreased, especially 0-6 years.
- None of the young families, children 0-6 years comes on Fri. nor Sun. since the pandemics.
- The number of youth decreased also.

What will happen?

• If there were <u>NO New young family</u> coming to this church in 3-4 years, the children ministry will become a state of "emptiness" and the church will go to a new era of "aging"




